Notes: This platform was created and designed in 2004. While we have maintained functionality over this long period, we acknowledge that it fails to meet the evolving web accessibility standards. Thus we are actively engaged in a complete redesign of our platform, both website designs and underlaying technology, with the aim of full accessibility, by the end of 2027.
